

Sunrise District Dinner Award Criteria

Cubmaster of the Year – An adult volunteer registered as a Cubmaster in a Cub Scout pack is eligible to receive this award. The award is given to recognize outstanding performance in the Cubmaster position AND/OR service to the unit beyond what is typically expected of a Cubmaster.

Scoutmaster of the Year – An adult volunteer registered as a Scoutmaster in a Scouts BSA troop is eligible to receive this award. The award is given to recognize outstanding performance in the Scoutmaster position AND/OR service to the unit beyond what is typically expected of a Scoutmaster.

Committee Chair of the Year – An adult volunteer registered as a Committee Chair in a Cub Scout pack or Scouts BSA troop is eligible to receive this award. The award is given to recognize outstanding performance in the Committee Chair position AND/OR service to the unit beyond what is typically expected of a Committee Chair.

Scout of the Year – A youth registered in a Cub Scout Pack, Scouts BSA Troop, or Venture Crew is eligible to receive this award. The award is given to recognize outstanding achievement as a Scout AND/OR outstanding service to the unit or participation in the unit program beyond what is typically expected of a Scout. Award committee has discretion to select up to three recipients, one Cub Scout, one Scout, and one Venturer.

Charter Organization of the Year – A registered charter organization in the Sunrise District is eligible to receive this award. The award is given to recognize outstanding support and engagement of the organization's unit(s) AND/OR outstanding support and engagement of Scouting in the Sunrise District AND/OR support or engagement beyond what is typically expected of a Charter Organization.

Family of the Year – A family with two or more registered adults AND/OR youth in a Cub Scout Pack AND/OR Scouts BSA Troop AND/OR Venture Crew is eligible for this award. The award is given to recognize the family members' outstanding support of and participation in Scouting within the unit AND/OR the Sunrise District.

Spouse of the Year – A spouse of an adult registered in a Cub Scout pack, Scouts BSA troop, or Venture crew is eligible to receive this award. The award is given to recognize a spouse's outstanding support of their spouse's participation in Scouting. The recipient may, but is not required to, be registered in a Cub Scout pack, Scouts BSA troop, or Venture crew.

Spark Plug Award – An adult registered in a Cub Scout Pack, Scouts BSA Troop, Venture Crew, or the Sunrise District (e.g. as a Merit Badge Counselor or member of the District Committee) is eligible to receive this award. The award is given to recognize any adult who provides a "spark" to Scouting through their outstanding contributions to their unit AND/OR the Sunrise District*.

Limit of 1 Spark Plug per unit will be awarded.
