Scout Leader Qualifications

All Jamboree Scoutmasters, first, second, and third assistant Scoutmasters must meet the following:

- Possess a current BSA membership with a Boy Scout troop.
- Scoutmasters and first assistant must be at least 21 years old by the first day of the Jamboree.
- Second assistant Scoutmasters must be at least 18 years of age by the first day of the Jamboree.
- Third assistant Scoutmasters must be at least 18 years of age by the first day of the Jamboree, but not yet 21 years old by the last day of the Jamboree.
- Scoutmaster applicants must be currently registered with BSA.
- Second and third assistant Scoutmasters must be currently serving in any adult troop leadership position.
- Scoutmaster applicants must have completed Scoutmaster Leader specific training.

Venturing Leader Qualifications

All Venturing Advisors must meet the following requirements:

- Have a current BSA membership with a Venturing Crew.
- Be at least 21 years of age by the first day of the Jamboree.
- Complete Venturing leader specific training.
- Be actively serving as a Crew advisor or associate advisor.

All Applicant Qualifications

- All adult leaders must complete the BSA Youth Protection training within one year of the last day of the Jamboree.
- Have filed personal and health record by April 15, 2023.
- All must be approved by the Local Council.
- All fees must be paid to the Local Council per their payment schedule.
- Commit to recruit and retain a full 36-member troop/crew for the jamboree.
- Commit to attend the entire jamboree in July 2023. (Applications will not be accepted from leaders who cannot commit to the entire jamboree.)
- Commit to hold jamboree troop/crew meetings on a regular basis.
- Complete an interview with the California Inland Empire Council National Jamboree Committee.
- Participate in a Jamboree Scoutmaster/Crew Advisor training for the California Inland Empire Council National Jamboree Committee.
