Thank you for attending our Overnighter!! We are excited for you and your child/children to come and have fun. This packet is to give you all the information you will need. Please contact Nichole Horsley email: bsa.nichole@gmail.com or (951) 230-8774 with any questions.

- 1) Medical/ Consent Form. Included is the Medical/Consent form. **EVERYONE** needs to fill out the Medical/Consent Form. You only need to do Parts A&B. These forms will be given to our Camp Nurse and returned to you at Checkout.
- 2) All Vehicles must be backed into each parking stalls and keys need to be on the adult partner at all times. There is no Camping inside your vehicles. All campers must be in a campsite.
- 3) You will need to bring: ****Bunk Houses will be open and are required**** Sleeping Bags, Pillow, Change of Clothes, Hat, Jacket (IT WILL BE COLD), Toiletries, Camp Chair, Flashlights. Please bring a water bottle. We will provide water. *******DRINK WATER, DRINK WATER******* Because of the altitude you can become dehydrated very quickly.
- 4) Meals: Please bring a Sack Lunch for Saturday. Dinner Saturday and Breakfast for Sunday are provided. We will provide Snacks for Saturday.
- 5) If you are not staying overnight, we ask that you stay until after our campfire. Campfires are a special part of the Scouting Experience.
- 6) Headquarters & First-Aid will be located at the Lodge next to the dining hall.
- 7) Please stay off Rocks. The Painted rocks are special and we do not want the paint damaged.
- 8) Make sure everyone has a "Buddy".
- 9) You **MUST** stay with your Child/Children **AT ALL TIMES**.
