**REFUND POLICY:** Refunds will only be approved if cancellation is made in writing prior to the event date. Because most fees paid for events are actually spent prior to the event, refunds will be made only under the following conditions:

A. For the use of council camps or any overnight camping event, a written request must be received by Council Volunteer Services 30 calendar days before the event. The written request, submitted to Volunteer Services, must be in writing by the person who submitted the original reservation.

Cancellation requests received by the required deadline, stated above, will result in a full refund minus a non-refundable, non-transferable 15% fee.

B. In the case of emergency, injury, or illness, the exception request must be in writing and verified by a parent and/or guardian and a physician. The maximum available refund under this provision will be 50% of the total fee paid by the individual.

**LEADERSHIP:** Two deep leadership – The <u>Guide to Safe</u> Scouting requires a minimum of 2 adult leaders with each unit during any activity. One adult must be registered and over 21 years old; the second must be 18 years or older. The chartered organization is responsible for ensuring sufficient leadership is provided for all activities.

**T-SHIRTS:** T-shirts are available and are ordered separately, online. A limited number of t-shirts will be available for sale on the day of the event. T-shirts must be ordered by August 31, 2014 to pick them up at the event.

**LEADERS GUIDE:** A complete leader's guide will be emailed to the unit contact person. The guide and all other necessary forms will be available at on the council website. All camp forms (BSA Annual Health & Medical Record Form, Parent/Guardian Consent Form for Participation in a Council-Operated Camp/Activity and Tour Plan) are available at a council Scout center. Completed forms must be presented for review (but not turned in) during check-in.

**NO SMOKING:** Smoking will not be permitted at this event.

ALCOHOL& PETS: No alcoholic beverages or pets are permitted on site.
