Camp Emerson Provisional Camper Registration

Camp Emerson offers a program that makes it possible for individual Scouts to attend camp without their troop; this is called a provisional camp experience. A provisional camp may be appropriate because:

- > The home troop is not attending camp.
- > A Scout is not available to camp with his troop.
- > The Scout is visiting California for the summer and wants to go to Scout camp.
- > The Scout simply wants an extra week of camp.

Provisional camp is not intended to replace a Scout troop's long-term summer camp program, but rather ensure that all Scouts have the opportunity to attend camp. Upon arrival at camp (Sunday at 12:00 pm), the Scout will be put in contact with the troop they will be spending the week with until camp concludes (Saturday at 9:00 am). Each troop will be led by an experienced, trained, and trusted Scoutmaster and assistant.

Camp fees for provisional campers include a full week of camping, leadership, merit badges, outdoor programs, meals and fun!

If the youth is not currently registered with the Boy Scouts of America, an additional \$40 fee will apply.
